IRS (*Internal Revenue Service*) Requirements, 2005

For vehicles donated to the church with a fair market value of over \$500.

We (*Dexter UMC*) must provide the following to the IRS:

1. Date of donation
 2. Odometer reading at time of donation
 3. Vehicle's identification number (VIN)
 4. Donor's name and Social Security Number
- We must also issue IRS form 8282 to the donor stating the amount the church received for the sale of the vehicle. This amount is the maximum amount the donor can use as a deduction for income tax purposes.

 - If the church keeps the vehicle, the receipt must state the intended use of the vehicle and the intended period to be used, plus certify that the vehicle will not be sold before that period ends.

 - For vehicle donations with a fair market value of \$500 or less, acknowledge in writing to donor the value received for the vehicle and include odometer reading, donors name and address, VIN and description of vehicle plus date of donation.
